



Day 1: Departure from North America – Flight to Munich, Germany

Depart from various cities across the United States and take an international flight to Munich, the capital of Bavaria, Germany.

Day 2: Arrival in Munich – Transfer to Hotel

Upon arrival in Munich, you will be greeted by our enthusiastic Century Cruises tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in and rest.

Accommodation: Novotel Hotel Munich or similar 4-star hotel

Day 3: Munich – Passau Embarkation (B/D)

After breakfast, explore Munich's Old Town, the Town Hall, the Munich Residenz (exterior), and Marienplatz. In the afternoon, travel by bus to Passau, a border town between Germany and Austria, situated at the confluence of the Danube, Inn, and Ilz rivers, also known as the "Three Rivers City." Board the luxurious 5-star Amadeus Amara river cruise in the evening. Enjoy a welcome cocktail with the captain and crew, followed by a specially arranged welcome dinner (formal attire required).

Day 4: Danube River Cruise – Salzburg – St. Wolfgang – Linz (B/L/D)

After a delicious breakfast aboard the ship, take a bus to Salzburg, the city of music and the birthplace of Mozart. Visit the iconic Mirabell Gardens, the filming location of "The Sound of Music." Enjoy lunch locally before heading to St. Wolfgang, a beautiful town in Austria's Lake District, known for its stunning natural beauty and as a summer retreat for Princess Sisi. Return to the ship for dinner.

Day 5: Danube River Cruise - Melk - Dürnstein (B/L/D)

After breakfast on the ship, travel to the UNESCO-listed Melk Abbey, one of the most beautiful Baroque monasteries in the world. After lunch, enjoy a guided walking tour of Dürnstein, a charming village nestled along the Danube River, famous for its historical architecture and picturesque views. Visit the landmark blue Baroque-style church.

Day 6: Danube River Cruise – Vienna, Austria (B/L/D)

After breakfast, disembark to explore Vienna, the City of Music. Visit the Hofburg Palace (exterior), St. Stephen's Cathedral, and the renowned Vienna State Opera (optional activity). In the afternoon, enjoy a visit to Schönbrunn Palace (optional activity), the former summer residence of Empress Maria Theresa. If you're lucky, you may experience a Mozart concert at the famous Golden Hall, marking the perfect end to your Vienna adventure.

Day 7: Danube River Cruise – Bratislava, Slovakia (B/L/D)

After breakfast, arrive in Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia. Visit the iconic Bratislava Castle, offering panoramic views of the city. Explore the historical Old Town, including the Slovak Philharmonic, Michael's Gate, and Roland Fountain. Keep an eye out for the unique notably short statue, a beloved local landmark. Return to the ship for dinner.

Day 8: Danube River Cruise – Esztergom – Budapest, Hungary (B/L/D)

After breakfast, travel to the small town of Esztergom, once the capital of Hungary, and visit the magnificent Esztergom Basilica. Afterward, return to the ship for lunch and enjoy an afternoon of relaxation on



the cruise. As the ship sails into Budapest, join the farewell reception on board, complete with the captain and crew to bid you a fond farewell. Enjoy a special farewell dinner (formal attire required).

Day 9: Danube River Cruise – Budapest, Hungary (B/L/D)

In the morning, explore the historic Buda Castle and Fisherman's Bastion, iconic landmarks of Budapest. Day 12: Prague Sightseeing (B)

After breakfast, take a guided tour of Prague Castle (optional activity), visiting St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, and Golden Lane. In the afternoon, explore Prague's Old Town, crossing the famous Charles Bridge to the Old Town Square, where you'll find the iconic Astronomical Clock, built in 1410. Return to the hotel in the evening for dinner and rest.

Day 13: Prague – Departure (B)

After breakfast, your tour concludes with a transfer to the airport in Prague for your flight back home, marking the end of an unforgettable journey along the Danube River.
